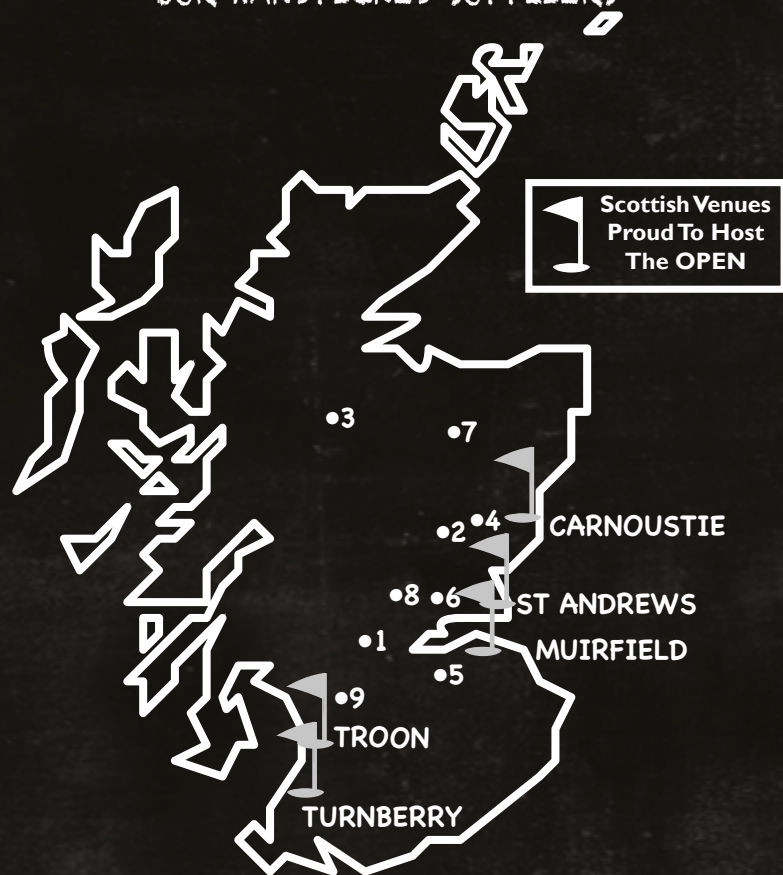

The Royal and Ancient Clubhouse was built in 1854, and was originally a single story building of four rooms: the large hall (known today as the Big Room), reading room, billiards room and club room.

The origins of the Museum go back to 1864 when The Royal and Ancient Golf Club decided "to collect such articles relative to the game for their due preservation."

Golf was first recorded in a 1457 Act of Parliament, in which it was banned by King James II of Scotland.
